Membership Chairman (Gerry Petraitis)

Membership Chair Petraitis reported that the club has 278 members (178 primary members and 100 family members).

During the pandemic stay-at-home measures, approximately 20 people have expressed interest in joining the club. Gerry is preparing to send out an invitation for club orientation. He will be studying the requirements of Virginia's Phase 2 reopening to ensure that the orientation class comports with those requirements. He will strive to balance public health concerns with the new club member's concerns. He will err on the side of caution with regard to the health of all concerned.

We hope to soon be able to allow for dues to be paid on-line and/or the with the use of a Square account.

Field Targets Captain (Elise Walker)

Field Captain Walker reported that the pathway along Target 11 has been eroded. The path is narrow. She is looking at how best to fix this. It may require some materials (rebar, lumber). She made a rough estimate that the repairs would require approximately \$500 in materials.

3-D Course Captain (Jeff Van de Vaarst)

3-D Captain Van de Vaarst made changes to eight targets on the range. He is waiting on delivery from Hoffman Archery for new targets that the club has ordered.


Elise Walker reported a concern regarding target 24. Jeff indicated that he would put up a warning sign.

Uwe has refined the sign-in form to account for the different ways that people sign in. As of the June 4 meeting, 63 members have signed in 205 times. It is imperative that you sign in the same way every time – please don't change your name, i.e. from "Robert" to "Bob." Do not include guests in the party size or enter NORVA members in the guest fields, otherwise the count will be off. Finally, remember to sign out when you leave. If you have lost the sign-out page while at the range, just start a new sign-in with the same member name. It will detect that you have an open sign-in.

The sign-in form will help us determine which facilities are most popular. Thus far, most members that sign in have marked the practice range as their intended use. The 3-D course is second in amount of use.
