Message from the Board

As required in NORVA's by-laws, this Newsletter is a report to the membership of the Board's actions. It also constitutes the minutes from the March 2022 meeting.

General Items

The March 2022 meeting was held on-line. It was led by club Vice President Ken Wilkinson.

March 19 Work Party

There was a discussion in anticipation of the March 19 Work Party.

We had a great turnout at the Work Party. Tasks included repairing steps on the 3-D course, replacing stakes for the 60-yard practice lane, clearing out debris near the shed, and tearing down the old outhouse that had been out of use for over a decade. The stakes on the 60-yard lane will be painted soon, after we lay the lane with gravel.

Paying for snacks and drinks

Treasurer John Shea reported that there is now a QR code on the clubhouse refrigerator to pay for snacks and drinks. We will look into using a similar payment method for the sale of food and merchandise at Club shoots.

Storage for the Club

There was a discussion of the possibility of purchasing a container to help with our storage needs. It was noted that these containers could get extremely hot in the summer. The Club will obtain quotes and revisit this idea at a later meeting.
