Message from the Board

General Items

The April 2024 meeting was led by President Ken Wilkinson.

Internet service for the clubhouse

There was a discussion on how to obtain internet service for the clubhouse. The Board will continue to explore possibilities, including the company that provides internet to the Fountainhead Park office.

Hunters for the Hungry Shoot

The Belvoir Bowhunters asked to move the date for the Hunters for the Hungry Shoot that they host at NORVA. It has been rescheduled to August 10.

Termites at the clubhouse

The clubhouse has been invaded by another pest – this time it is termites. A pest-control company came out to spray and treat the clubhouse the week of April 8.

Membership (Gerry Petraitis)

There were 21 people at the April new member orientation. That brings the club's total membership to 738.

Hunting Chair (Mark Finkenstaedt)

Our urban landscape offers several upcoming opportunities for both experienced and novice hunters, and it is time to act. Whitetail deer are one of the pinnacle game animals, and Fairfax County is asking bowhunters for help in managing the County's deer population.

The **Fairfax County Deer Management Program** is the County's primary tool to manage deer population. This program enlists the aid of local bowhunters at county and regional parks. In order to participate in this program, you must first be qualified. The qualification period this year runs from April 19 to June 23, 2024.

The program's requirements are extensive and should be read carefully and dates noted: https://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/wildlife/archery-program

NORVA has always fielded an energetic core of highly proficient archers volunteering hundreds of hours to the program. We encourage anyone interested to take part and we offer expert advice for novice and lifelong hunters new-the-area about the program's nuance.

You can be qualified to participate in the program at NORVA. Club qualifiers include Uwe Jacobs, John McKenzie, Joe Wolfe, and Mark Finkenstaedt. Typically we post "qual" dates/times on the Facebook page. The qualification period ends quickly (only two months), so practice the "qual" jitters away.

Crossbows are permitted at the Broadhead range only during these sessions. For crossbow users without suitable places to sight/test we can hold special sessions. These will not be the same day as your qualifications.

You will also need to attend an IBEP (International Bowhunters Education Program) class in person if you don't have this qualification. Online versions are not recognized by the program. Classes are held by DWR, FCDMAP and soon at NORVA, so get signed up as seats can be limited.

Here are several helpful tips for qualifying:

- Check your gear and practice with broadheads. (<u>Added precautions please!</u>)
- Practice daily before qualifying.

- Donuts and coffee are welcome at the qualification session, but we will still fail you . . . without practice.
- 20 and 30 yards is easy...with practice.
- Do not practice one hour before qualifying that's the rule.
- Practice cooking sides.
