## Message from the Board

## **General Items**

The July 2024 meeting was led by President Ken Wilkinson.

### Clubhouse in use August 17

NORVA will be hosting members of Cub Run Archers for a safety briefing on August 17 at 5:00 pm. The NORVA Clubhouse will be used for the event.

#### New name for the pavilion

Secretary Jim Libovicz moved to name the Club's practice pavilion the "Shea Pavilion" to honor outgoing Treasurer John Shea for his efforts in getting the pavilion built and for his countless hours of hard work on many other projects. He has helped to make NORVA the outstanding organization that it is. The measure was passed unanimously. Thank you, John, for all that you have done for our club.

#### A request to volunteers

From time to time, a dead tree falls over to block a path on the club grounds. On more than one occasion, a generous club member has taken a chainsaw to cut it down into smaller pieces. The Club is extremely grateful for this spirit of selflessness. However, we do ask that you not do this by yourself. Please, in the interest of safety, if you are using a chainsaw, have a buddy with you. Thanks.

#### **Eagle Scout volunteer**

President Ken Wilkinson has been approached by an Eagle Scout candidate interested in doing volunteer work for the Club. Ken has proposed some possible projects, such as bridge repair, trail maintenance, target frames, and bow hangars. The candidate is considering the suggestions; she will get back to him with a proposal.

### **Modifications to Targets**

There have been a number of instances of members modifying targets on club ranges. For example, the right target bale on the 60-yard practice range was recently painted with a vertical and horizontal black line (presumably to facilitate group tuning). Please do not modify target bales, especially with permanent aiming references, which only serve to concentrate arrows in a specific area (prematurely wearing the target). In this case, the same purpose could have been served by using a piece of cardboard with a tape line.

Additionally, targets 27 and 28 of the Field Course are often used by members for practice purposes. This is a perfectly valid use of these target lanes. However, more often than not, members are changing target faces for their preferred target face and then leaving things in place when they leave. Please return target faces to their original configuration. The Field Course is set up monthly for specific National Field Archery Association games. These games are "Field" (white face with black center), "Hunter" (black face with white center), and "Animal" (paper animal face).

## Events (Susan Erdos)

Susan is setting up a meeting with the Belvoir Bowhunters members who will be running the August Hunters for the Hungry shoot. The shoot is scheduled for August 10; Susan hopes to meet with them on August 9.

## Membership (Gerry Petraitis)

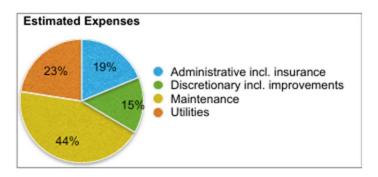
